Support the "Placitas Withdrawal"

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has proposed a plan - an administrative withdrawal - to protect more than 4,000 acres within the Placitas area from gravel and other mining for 50 years. The area to be protected includes the **Buffalo Tract**, the **Crest of Montezuma** and two additional small tracts.

A 90-day comment period began September 20 and ends December 19, 2023. The BLM is soliciting public comment to make the case to the Dept. of the Interior for approval of this withdrawal. The BLM/DOI want to know why the Placitas Withdrawal is important.
